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Prep for SRXEMR003A – Administer Oxygen in an Emergency Situation

In order to be properly prepared to take the Administer Oxygen in an Emergency Situation course (SRXEMR003A), you need to ensure that you have completed the following preparation **before** the course date:

- 1) Have a current Statement of Attainment for HLTF311A (or HLTF301C) – Apply First Aid (this may be called First Aid at Work or Senior First Aid, and can be issued by PADI’s RTO, the Red Cross, Saint John’s Ambulance, etc). Please bring a copy of your Statement with you. **Please check the date! It MUST have been issued within the past 3 years. If your First Aid is out of date, it must be re-done prior to/ in conjunction with the Oxygen course.**
- 2) Have a current Statement of Attainment for HLTCPR211A (or HLTCPR201B) - Perform CPR – within the last 12 months. Please bring a copy of your Statement with you. **Note:** The CPR course can be done in conjunction with the O2 course for an additional cost.
- 3) Have a copy of the PADI Emergency Oxygen Provider manual, and have read it completely
- 4) Have completed the Knowledge Reviews on page 43-45 (I will need to retain a copy for my records, so please bring a copy with you)
- 5) Have read the PADI Asia Pacific Administer Emergency Oxygen Student Notes available for download from the website in the RESOURCES section (www.goprotownsville.com) or by following this direct link – <http://www.goprotownsville.com/resources/O2/notes.pdf>
